Tony has 30 years experience in the medical device and pharmaceutical industries with most of his career spent in general management, new product development, and operations. Currently, Tony is CEO of Advanced Chemotherapy Technologies (ACT). In this role Tony has secured \$12M in financing and is leading the company to its first human clinical trial for treatment of pancreatic cancer.



Prior to ACT, Tony was founder and CEO of Novocor Medical Systems were he raised over \$4M in financing and lead the organization to FDA clearance of Hypocore™, a medical device that chills IV fluids to induce therapeutic hypothermia in cardiac arrest patients. Prior to Novocor, Tony worked at Ethicon/Closure Medical were he served in several roles including Director of Operations, Director of Product Development, Director of R&D and Managing Director for the Raleigh facility. Closure Medical is best known for developing the wound closure technology, known as Dermabond®. In 2005, Ethicon bought Closure Medical for \$420M. Prior to Closure, Tony joined Abbott Laboratories in North Chicago, IL where he held multiple positions in product development and manufacturing. Tony is a graduate of North Carolina State University in Chemical Engineering and spent a short stent in industrial chemical production.
